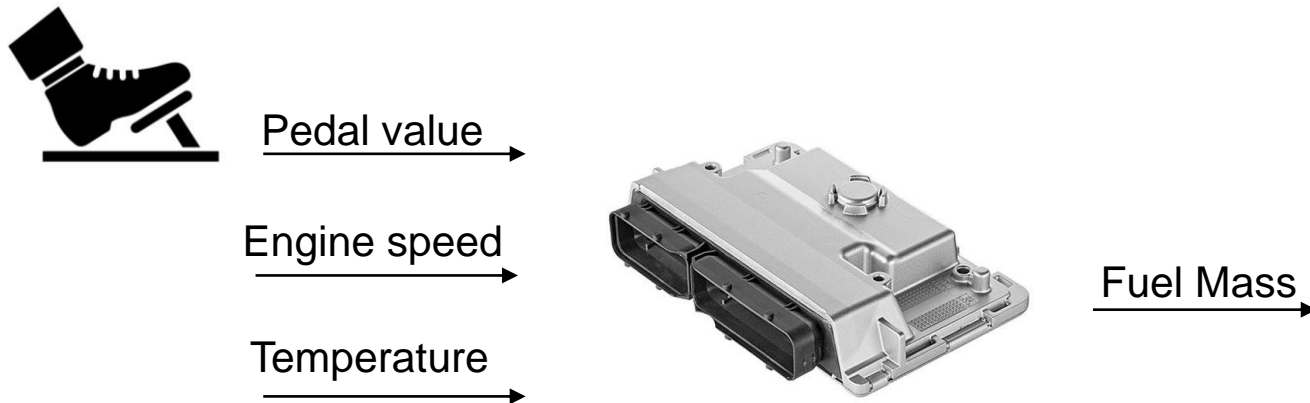

Classical ECU Functions

What is an ECU Function ?

- › Mapping Input Signals to Output signals

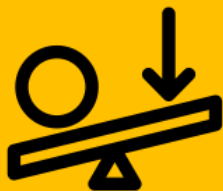


Classical ECU Functions

Advantages/Disadvantages

Advantages

- › Physically motivated
- › High understanding of what's going on (intermediate signals have typically physical units)
- › Enabling “transfer learning” for single HW change



Disadvantage

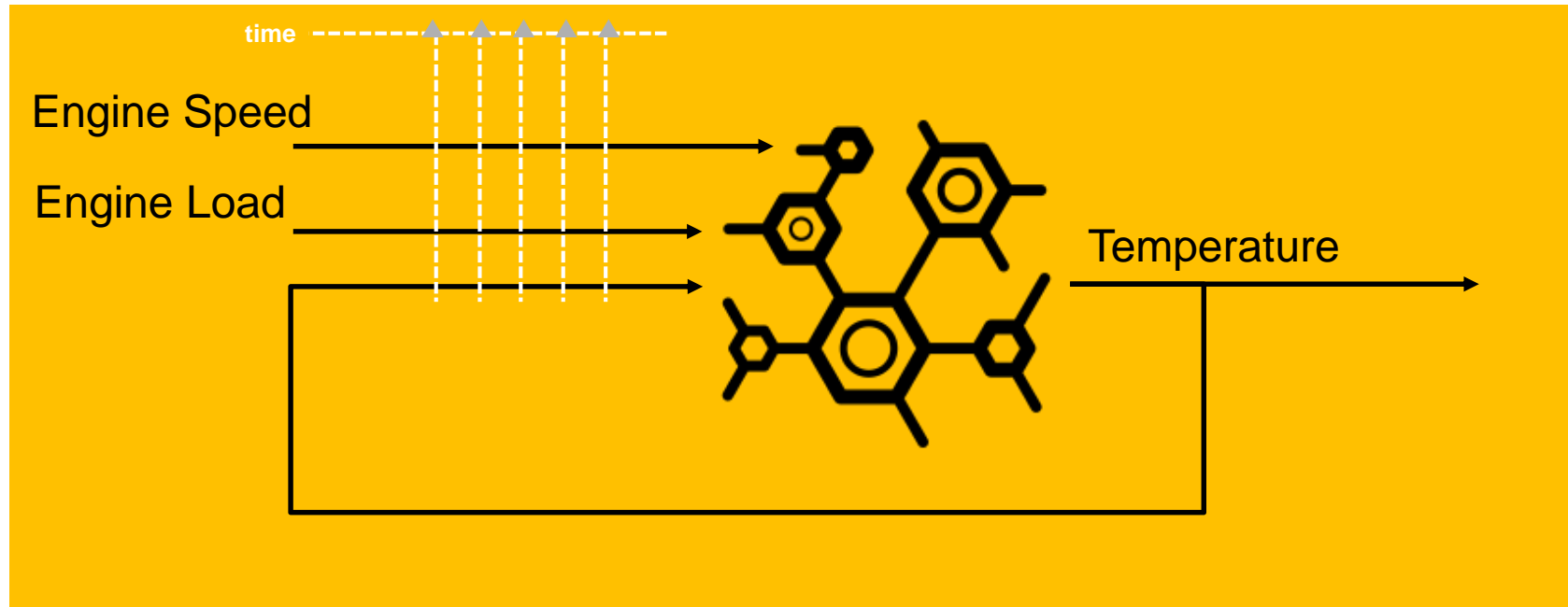
- › Require development (modelling + coding)
- › Require methodology development for calibration = training
- › Require tooling for the training (backpropagation)
- › Require very special measurements from engine test bench



Deep Dynamical Systems

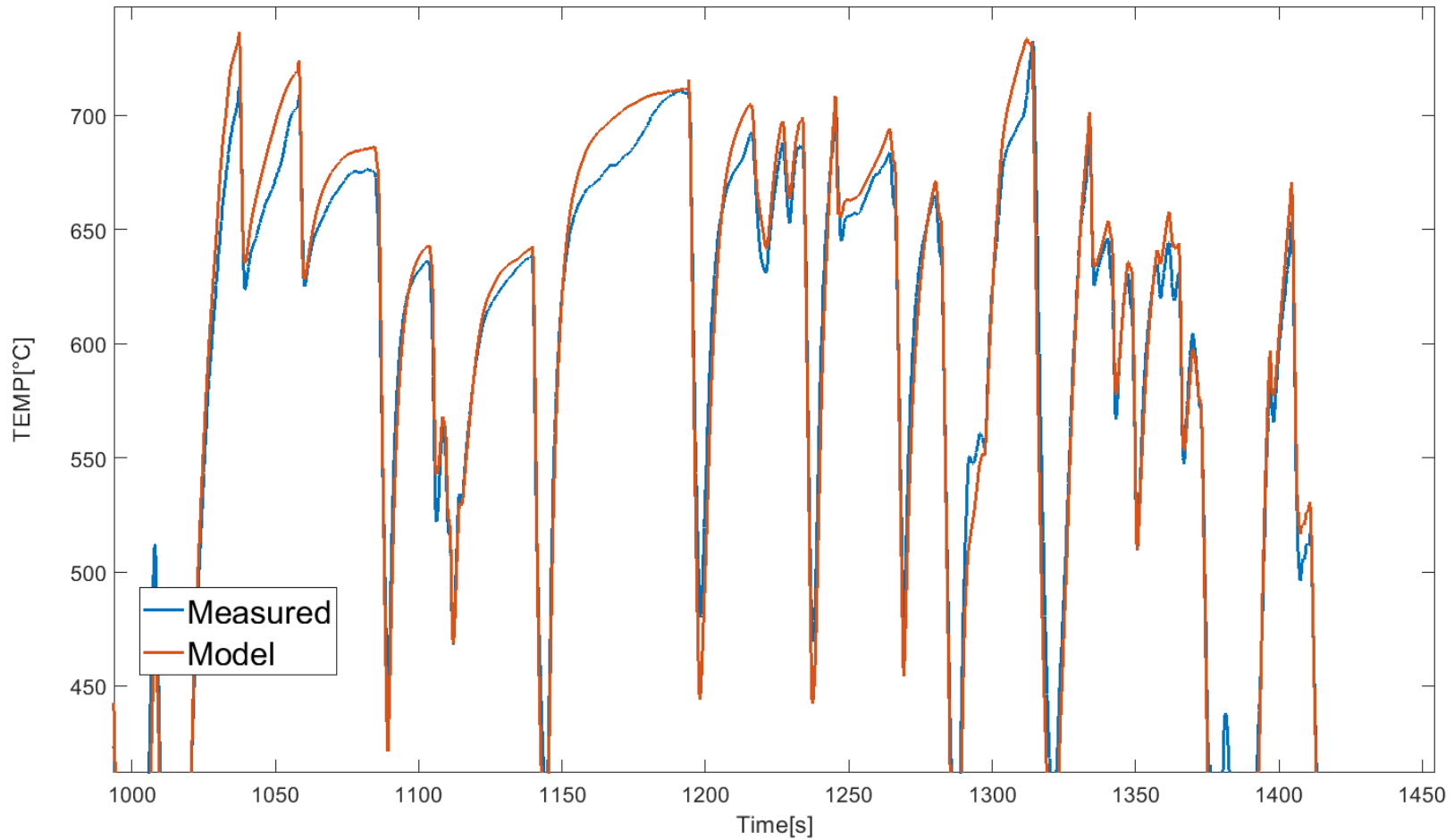
Network overview

- › No LSTM (Long Short-Term Model)
- › NARX (Nonlinear autoregressive neural network)

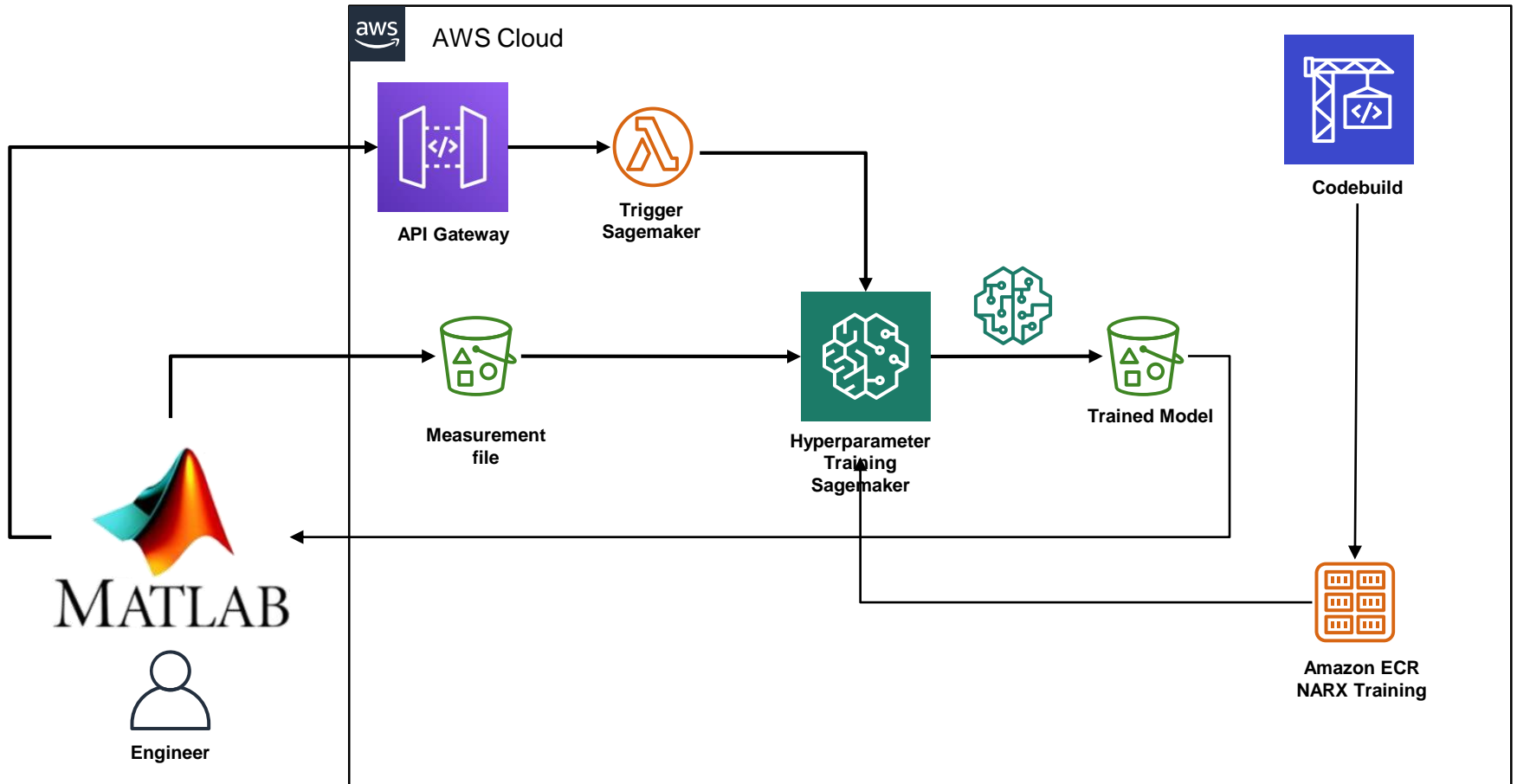

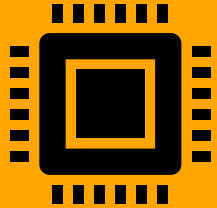
Temperature example 40min of driving (validation)

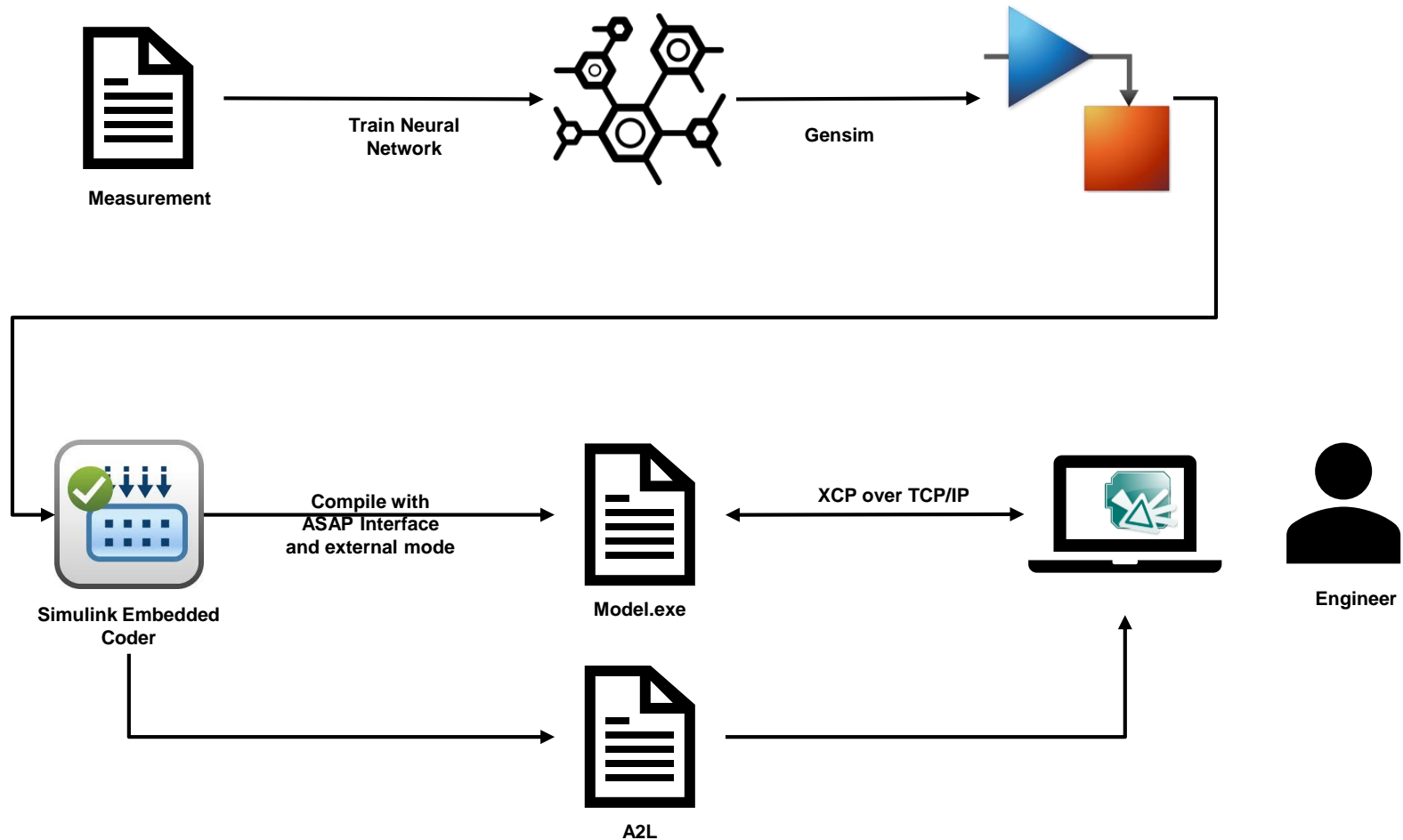

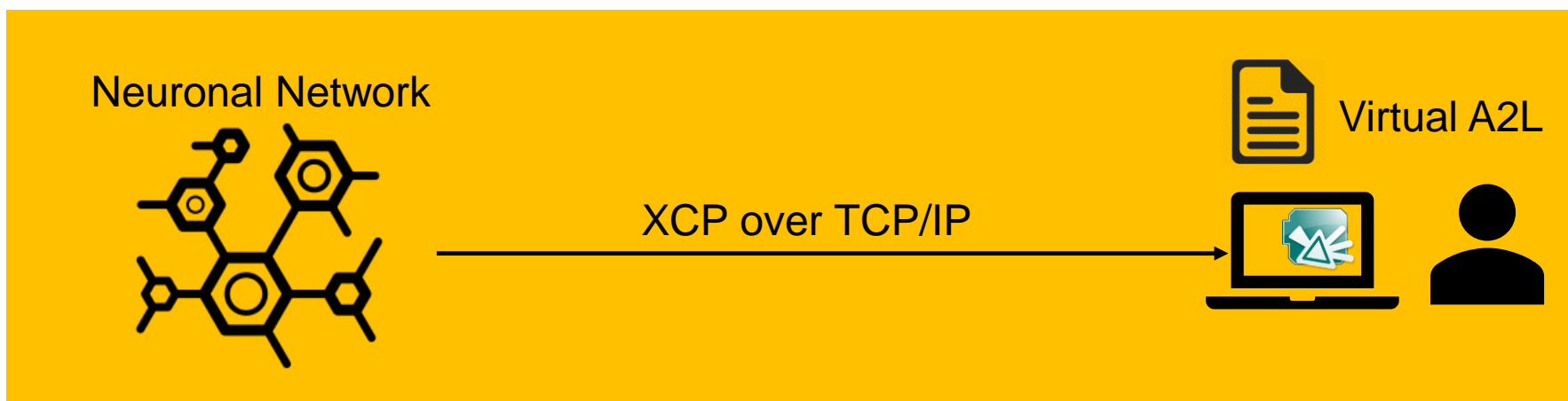
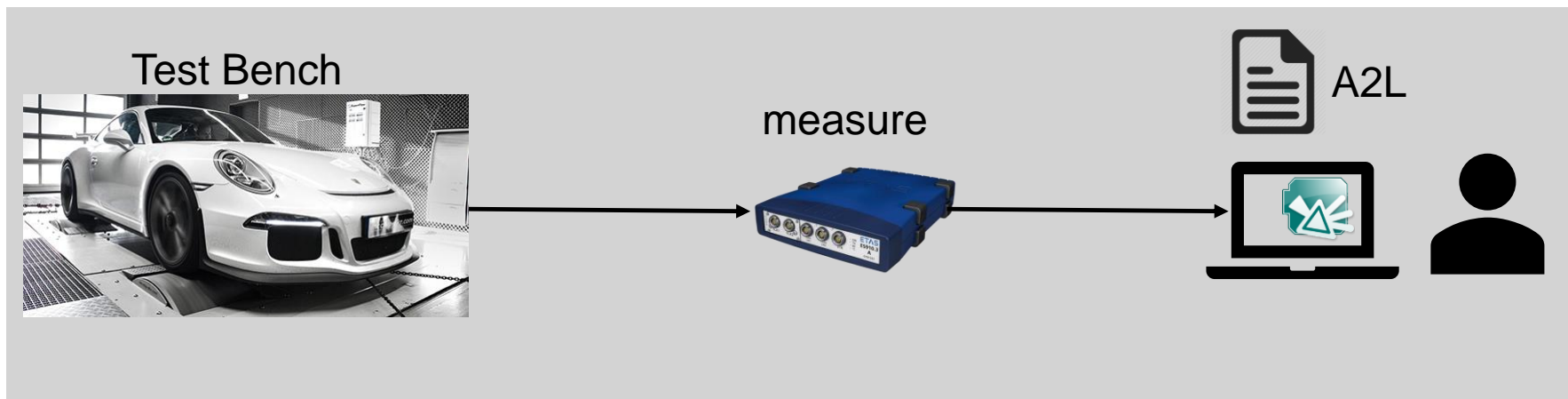
